2017 marks 100 years since women gained the right to vote in New York. Our keynote speaker this year is University at Albany Lecturer Dr. Laurie Kozakiewicz, who will speak on Ladies Day at the Capitol: New York's Women Legislators 1919 – 2015.

The Renaissance Albany Hotel is located in the former DeWitt Clinton Hotel building at 144 State Street (corner of State and Eagle Streets) in downtown Albany.

From Interstate 787 southbound, take Exit 3B toward Empire State Plaza, drive beneath the Plaza, and turn right onto Swan Street. Turn right at the light onto State Street and proceed to Eagle Street.

From I-787 northbound, take Exit 3 towards Empire State Plaza, then follow the directions above.

On-street parking is available on State Street. You may also park in the Renaissance Albany garage at 67 Howard Street (the red automobile icon on the map below marks the approximate location of the garage entrance) and enter the hotel at Stairwell A on the first level. Validation is available.
